SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

General information

Remove contaminated soaked clothing immediately. In the event of persistent symptoms receive medical treatment. Take away from danger area and lay down affected person.

After inhalation

8.2. Exposure controls

Appropriate engineering controls
